CONFERENCE TOPICS

Smoke-free Europe

Towards Smoke-free Europe

Passive smoking and health, economic effects of a smoke-free policy, efficient implementation of smoke-free legislation, effects of passive smoking in relation to other environmental problems, such as asbestos, particulate matter, air pollution.

WHO Framework Convention on Tobacco Control

Implementation of the ratification in Europe, FCTC protocols, role of governments and NGO's concerning other protocols, such as Kyoto.

Smoking Cessation

New treatments, role of health professionals, training programs, interventions for foreign populations and socially underprivileged populations, women and cessation, experiences with new media and cessation.

Product Regulation

Smokeless tobacco, additives, "safer" cigarettes, new products for the non-medical delivery of nicotine.

Harm Reduction

Smoking reduction – a serious perspective or an illusion? Replacement products and experiences from other fields such as illegal drugs.

New Results: Health and Tobacco

Smoking and obesity, diabetes, breast cancer, multiple sclerosis, periodontal disease, mucosa.

Smoking and Youth

Behavioral prevention among adolescents – still a matter of actuality? Influence of price, advertising and bans on sales to youth, school programs, interventions in the "leisure time" setting, tobacco industry and youth.

Smoke-free Sports and Art

Tobacco promotion through sports and cultural events, especially smoking movies. How can the world of sports and art contribute to tobacco control and prevention? Sport events have to become smoke-free in the near future.

More Topics

Influence of the Tobacco Industry Strategies, national programs, socio-economical costs of smoking, etc.

A special focus will be given to questions of gender aspects and accessibility for socially underprivileged people, in all conference topics.

RESULTS OF THE CONFERENCE

- EU-Commission gets new impetus to implement the Tobacco Control policies
- New instruments are provided for the whole of Europe after the conference (e.g. common definitions, monitoring of the FCTC implementation)
- Mobilization of new groups, building new alliances:
 - *health area*: heart organisations, respiratory organisations, laryngeal patients
 - *authorities/politics*: additional administrative departments (e.g. environmental and consumer protection)
 - *sports and culture*: international associations
 - *civilian population*: e.g. women's organisations, religious communities
